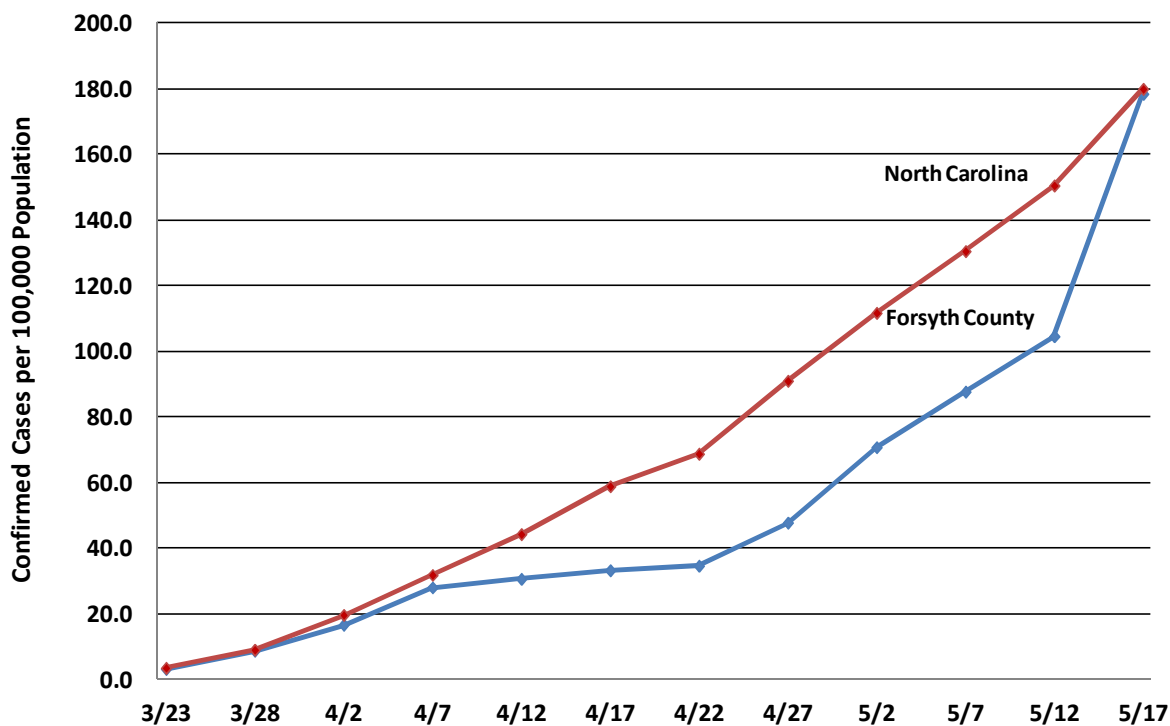

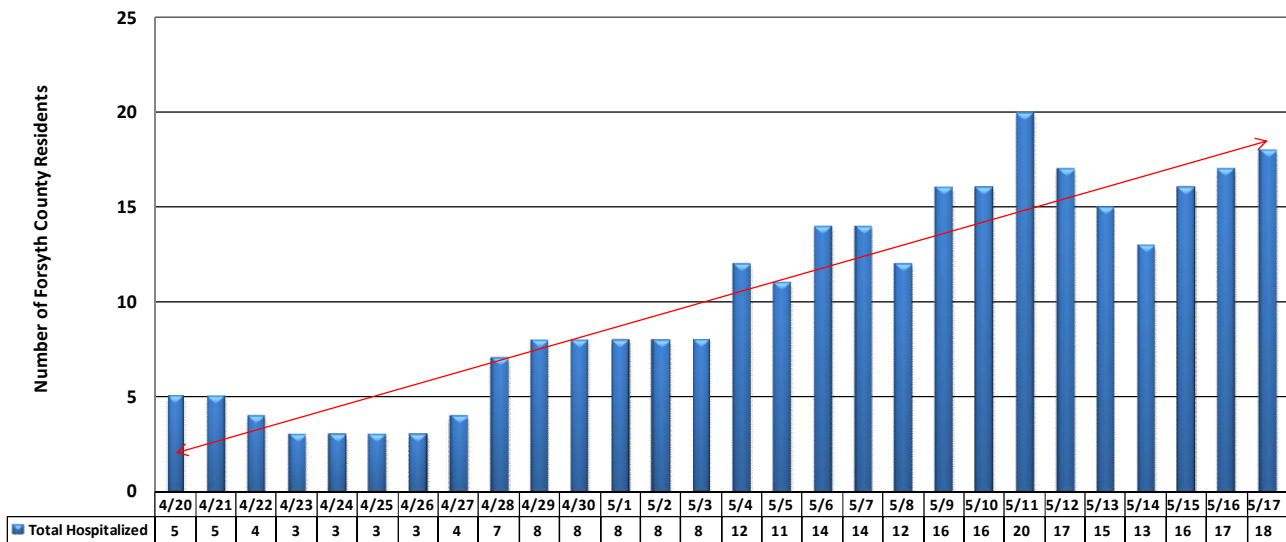
**Figure 1. Trend in Confirmed COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 Population
