Forsyth County Government COVID-19 Daily Briefing April 30, 2020

Updated daily by 11:30am

Thirty-two new cases have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 242 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All cases reported by the Forsyth County Department of Public Health are Forsyth County residents. Of the 242, 123 have recovered. The cases that are related to the Tyson Facility in Wilkes County are Forsyth County residents, and the majority of new cases since April 27th are related to Tyson. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the May 7th Board of County Commissioners briefing, which will be conducted remotely. The Public Health Director will hold a Question & Answer session with the media at 4:00pm today. A call-in number was sent to the media.




Public Health Director Comment

COVID-19 cases reported by the health department are Forsyth County residents. A detailed breakdown of tests in Forsyth County is reported every Monday with data provided by NC DHHS."


