# Forsyth County Government COVID-19 Daily Briefing May 10, 2020

Updated daily by 11:30am

Seventeen new cases have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 386 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All cases reported by the Forsyth County Department of Public Health are Forsyth County residents. Of the 386, 176 have recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the May 14th Board of County Commissioners briefing, which will be conducted remotely. 
#### **Public Health Director Comment**


