COVID-19 Daily Briefing

May 13, 2020

Updated daily by 11:30am

Fifty new cases have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 495 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All cases reported by the Forsyth County Department of Public Health are Forsyth County residents. Of the 495, 210 have recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the May 14th Board of County Commissioners briefing, which will be conducted remotely. 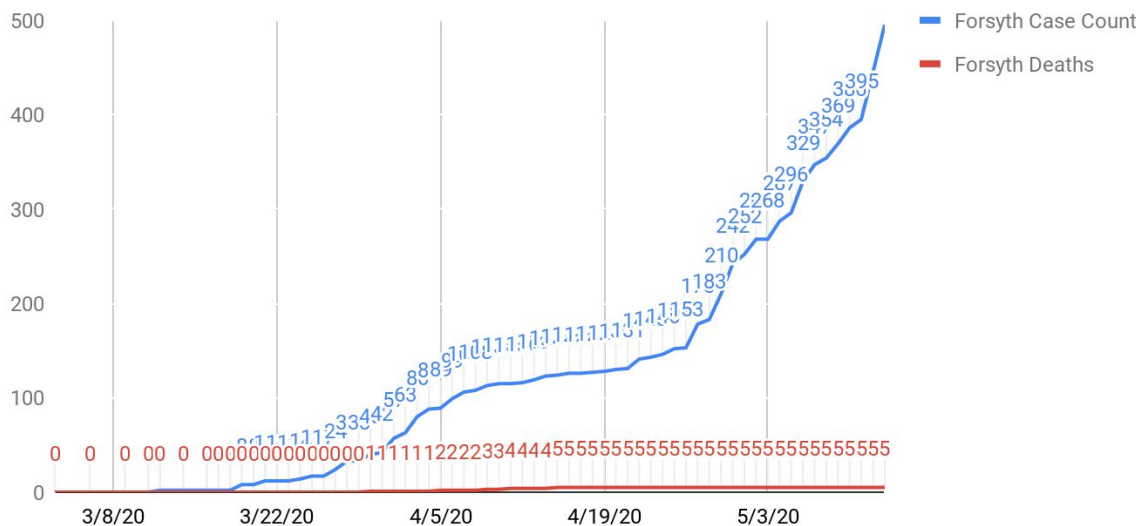
Public Health Director Comment

Public Health Director Joshua Swift commented, "Today's case increase is under investigation. Many of the cases from yesterday appear to be connected to close contacts such as family members and loved ones. It is important, even when at home, to practice good hygiene, proper cleaning and social distancing from sick family members. Family members should also limit their errands to only one or two household members."
