COVID-19 Daily Briefing

May 26, 2020

Updated daily by 11:30am

Forty-four new cases have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 1012 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All cases reported by the Forsyth County Department of Public Health are Forsyth County residents. Of the 1012, 361 have recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The COVID-19 surveillance report is being released without the total test information. Once we receive all of the data from our healthcare partners, the report will be updated. This delay ensures that we are reporting the data as accurately as possible.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the May 28th Board of County Commissioners briefing, which will be conducted remotely. 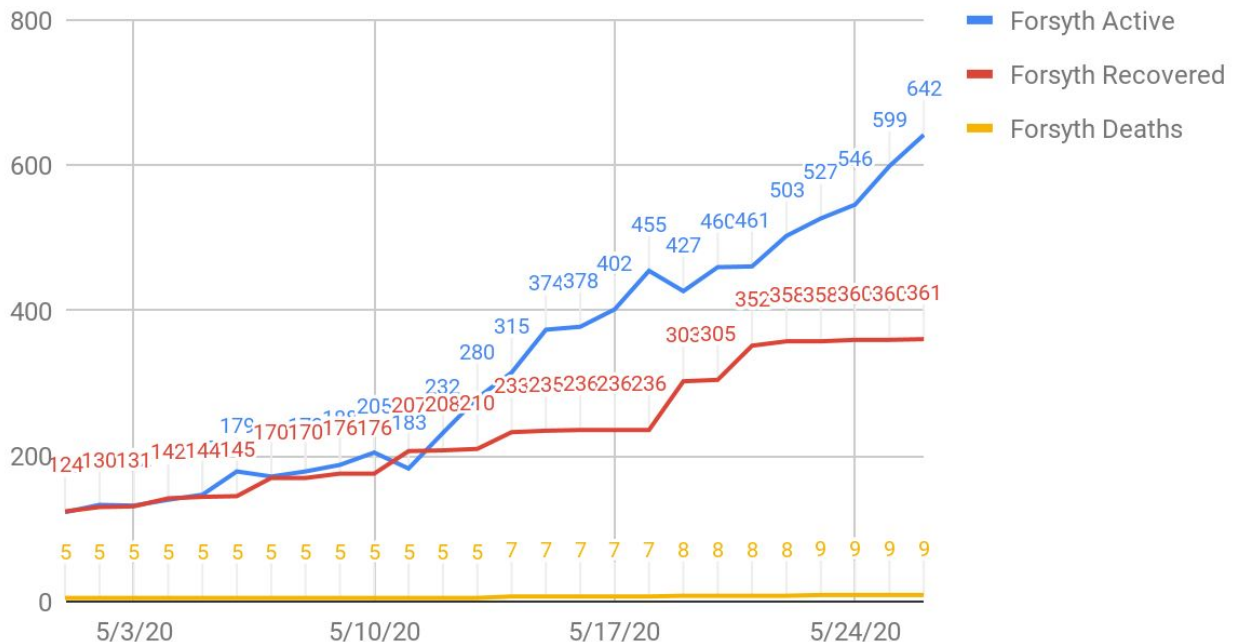
The Public Health Director will hold a Question & Answer session with the media at 4:00pm on May 28th. A call-in number will be sent to the media today.

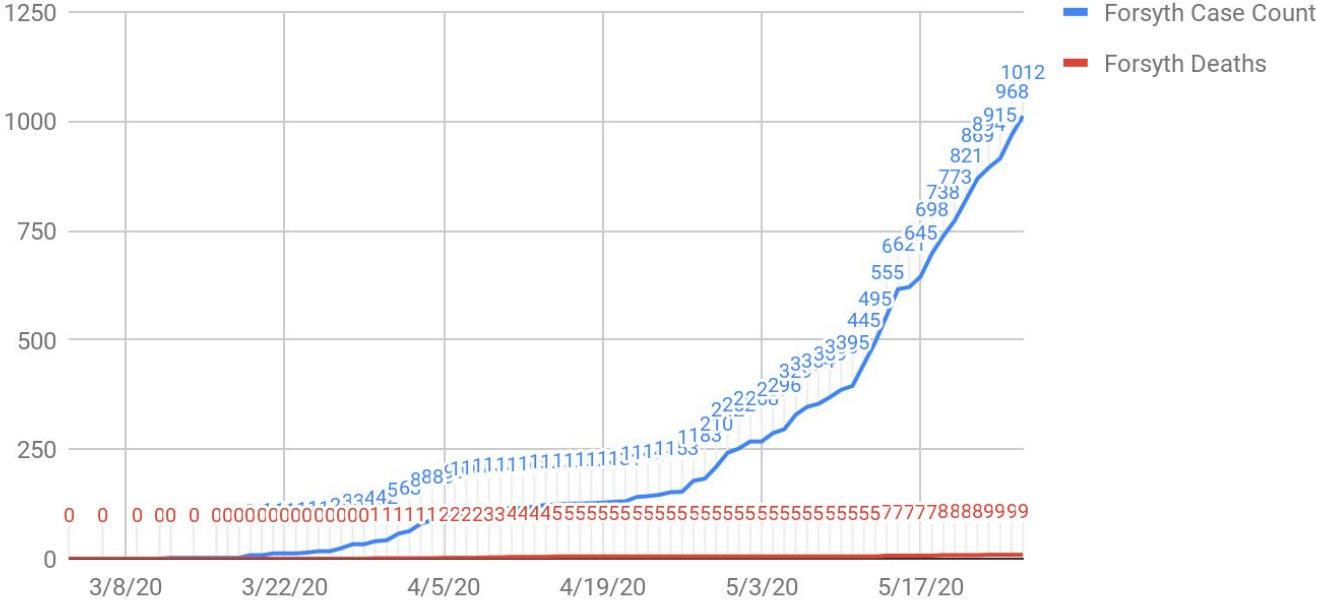
