# Forsyth County Government COVID-19 Daily Briefing June 11, 2020

Updated weekdays by 12:30pm

Forty-two new cases have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 1,967 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All cases reported by the Forsyth County Department of Public Health are Forsyth County residents. Of the 1,967, 1,188 have recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing. **Starting the week of June 8, the daily briefing will no longer be provided on the weekends.** 

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the today's Board of County Commissioners briefing, which will be conducted remotely. 
The Public Health Director will hold a Question & Answer session with the media at 4:00pm today. A call-in number was sent to the media.



## Forsyth County COVID-19 Cases




Active and recovered data starting May 1, 2020
